PRESCHOOL FAMILIES

As we head towards the end of a wonderful year in Pre School, Rose Petal children and parents are invited to attend a small Graduation assembly in the school hall on Wednesday 8th July, 9:15 finishing around 9:45. Those children who do not usually attend Pre school on a Wednesday are invited to attend too with their parent/carer. It would be lovely to see as many children there as possible to celebrate the end of their Pre School journey. Please inform Mrs Gimmi/Pre school staff if your child is able to attend.

MORE INFORMATION FOR ABSENCES

If your child is absent from school and you email admin@stroses.herts.sch.uk or leave a voicemail explaining that your child is absent we will require more information. We are currently being given reasons for absence as 'unwell' 'not coming in' 'not 100%' 'had a bad night' which are unclear. The office will be calling/emailing all parents who do not give clear information of exactly why their child is not in school.

INVENTORY SIGNING IN SYSTEM

When arriving after 8.40am the classroom doors will be closed and registers will be taken you MUST bring your child in through the office so that they can be registered using the Inventory system. Children entering class after 8.40am could not be noticed by the teacher and missed from the register.

When signing your child in on the Inventory system it will ask you for the reason for lateness. Please do not put the reason as 'late' or 'transport issues' please explain the reason why your child is late for that day. Thank you

ROSEBUDS FOR SEPTEMBER 2026

We are delighted to be able to continue offering wraparound care from September 2026. Demand for this service has been extremely high this year, and as a result we have had to make some changes in order to meet demand effectively.

From September, the booking process will be separated between our Pre-School and Nursery children, and our Reception to Year 2 children.

Due to staffing ratios, spaces for Pre-School and Nursery children will be limited, and sign-up request details for Rosebuds Breakfast and After School Club will be sent separately. Families will be required to commit to their chosen days for the full academic year.

For Reception to Year 2 children, we are able to maintain some flexibility and will continue to operate a termly booking system with dedicated sign-up windows via Arbor. We will now offer two booking options: Option 1 from 3:10pm–5:10pm, and Option 2 from 3:10pm–6:10pm.

The Reception - Year 2 booking window is open between - 15th June – 8th July 2026

The Reception – Year 2 cost of wrap around will be 3:10pm – 5:10pm £12.00 and 3:10pm – 6:10pm £16.00 (siblings receive a 50p discount).

The terms and conditions for September 2026 will be added to Arbor in due course and you must consent to them before your child can attend Rosebuds.

LOST PROPERTY

The lost property box (outside the school office) is beginning to fill up again. Any lost items in school that are clearly named will be returned to the child. Any unnamed items will be put in the box. At the end of this term the box will be donated to the PTA. Please take time over the coming weeks to check for anything your child may be missing.
